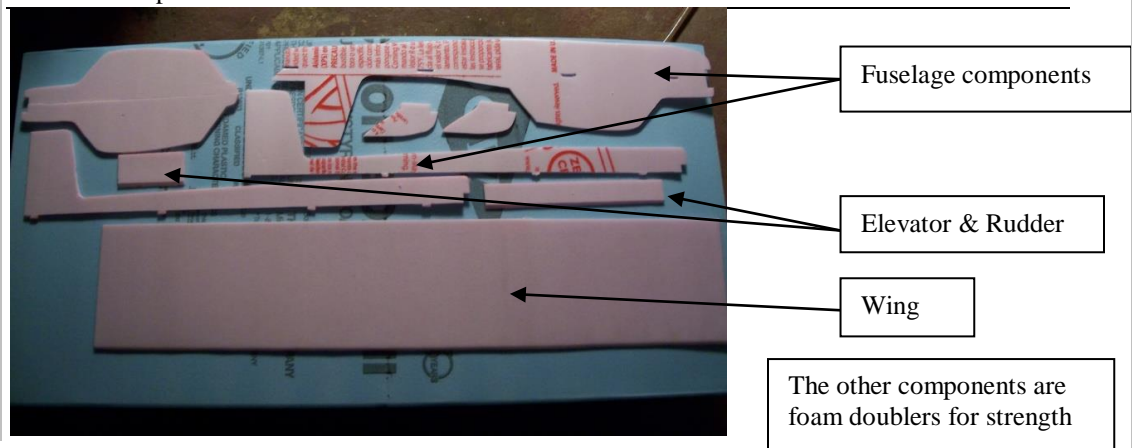
MEMBERSHIP CARDS

STARPOINT HIGH SCHOOL RC FLYING CLUB

The program at Starpoint is off to a great start. The club has the full support of the school's administration, a budget of \$500, 2 technology teachers, and 6 students. With the school budget we acquired a simulator with a computer radio and 4 motors and speed controllers. At the last Brauer's Aviators meeting our members donated \$160 for the completion of 4 airplanes. Thank You letters will be sent to these generous members who see the advantage in helping out new flyers and potential new members. The picture below shows how the components will be cut out of 1/4" foam and assembled into a working 3 channel airplane.

The sequence for this club is 4/19; cut out components, 4/26 start the assembly; 5/3 finish assembly and add components; 5/10 set up control surfaces and set CG.; 5/17 maiden flights in the gym; 5/24 & 5/31 outdoor flying. June 7 & 14 continue flying and develop the plan for 2019. The tentative plan for 2019 will be to build foam 4 channel F6Fs.



This promises to be a fun educational experience for all involved. There is only 1 senior student so the club will have a strong start for next year.
