MARCH MEETING AT THE MOOSE LODGE

Our next meeting will be Thursday, March 14^h at 7:00 PM. 75 Washington St, North Tonawanda. There is important club business on the agenda and you'll want to attend.

By-law number 9:

"Dues and assessments:

The annual dues and/or assessments to be paid to the club shall be determined by the club officers with a two-thirds (2/3) majority approval vote of the members present at the regular monthly meeting, and the members have been given five (5) days prior notice with an explanation. Dues are non-refundable. Dues are to be paid no later than the January club meeting.

Amended by a majority vote 01/15/09 - as of January 15, 2009, dues were set at fifty dollars (\$50.00). Dues will be twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for members who join after August 1. For A member joining after October first, dues will be fifty dollars (\$50.00) and membership will run until the end of the next year. Dues for Children/Grand Children of current members will be one dollar (\$1.00). Initiation fees are set at ten dollars (\$10.00) and will be the same for all members."

We will be discussing and voting on a dues increase which would take effect for anyone new or unpaid by the end of March of this year.

Explanation:

Our current dues structure has been in place since 2009. Costs have increased substantially since then. Our membership has also been declining as well as members not renewing in a timely manner or informing us that they do not intend to renew. This is making it difficult to budget responsibly.

** Please remember if you are not current with your dues and/or AMA membership you are not to be using the field.


