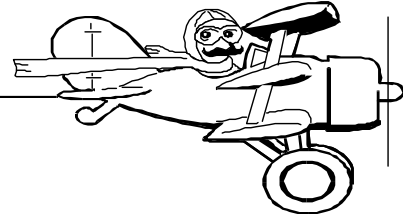

TRICKLE CHARGING PLANES IN YOUR VEHICLE

I always worry that I'm going to forget to unplug the cord before pulling out of the garage! So, to help me remember to unplug before driving away, I strap a "remove before flight" type tag to my steering wheel.
