## FAA DRONE ZONE

I just received an email reminder to renew my FAA registration. My current registration expires in March. Amazing how time flies. One is able to renew up to 6 months before it expires. As a reminder the web-site is <https://faadronezone-access.faa.gov> . Once you log in and go to your dashboard you'll see when your registration expires and you can renew and print it from there also.
